#### **COURSE STRUCTURE**

Each week you will receive:

- 28 lessons of English for Academic Purposes (21 hours)

7 Sessions of K+
Total: 21 hours + 5.25 hours of K+per week

Classes can alternate between mornings and afternoons. Your exact timetable will depend on the school of your choice.

#### ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PATHWAYS SPECIFIC SKILLS CLASS

The EAP Specific Skills class is a max. 20- week course which consists of 4 separate modules of 5 weeks each. In each module, students will have practice in:

- The process of academic writing (pre-writing, drafting and revising)
- Writing effective academic essays
- · Listening to academic lectures and utilize effective note-taking strategies
- Reading a variety of text types for academic purposes
- Taking part in academic discussion and communicating in academic and non-academic contexts
- Giving an academic presentation
- Utilizing a number of critical thinking skills

• Developing an understanding of university culture and expectations, including the concept of plagiarism

• Communicating with professors and faculty staff through email and face to face meetings

• Navigating group work and deadline management for academic projects and assignments
