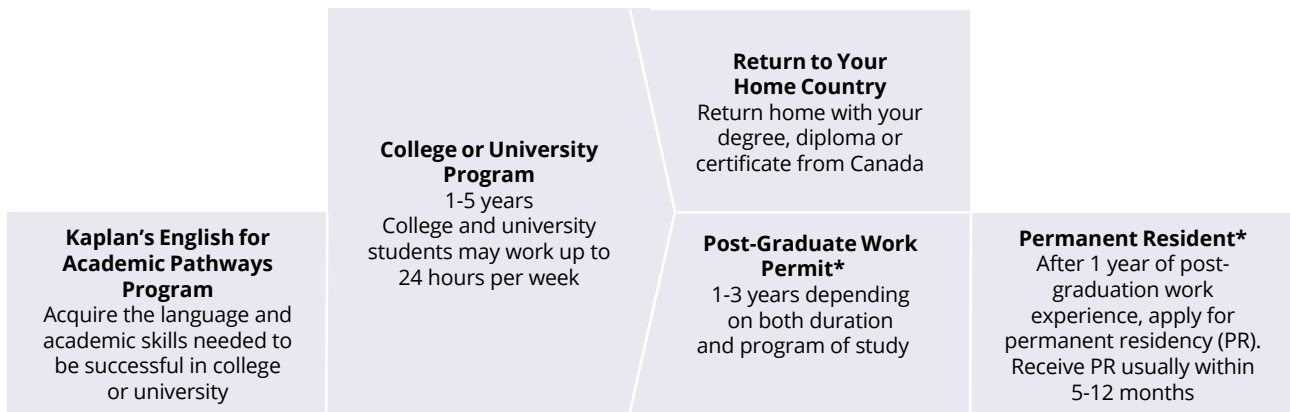

YOUR ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PATHWAYS PROGRAM (EAP)

Your program will consist of a combination of a General English and a Specific Skills class. Once you reach the Intermediate level, you have the option to change your General English classes to IELTS classes. At the Higher Intermediate level, you have the option to change your General English classes to TOEFL classes. All students must take the English for Academic Purpose (EAP) Specific Skills class upon reaching the Higher Intermediate level. Upon completion of the EAP program and passing the required level test for partner transfer, you will be issued the English for Academic Pathways Certificate.

The English for Academic Pathways Certificate is issued to students who have completed a minimum 5 weeks of the English for Academic Pathways Course and the required Kaplan level by passing the level test.

Students must keep in touch with their onsite academic advisors who will track their progress and issue the appropriate documentation when students have successfully completed the pathway requirements.

WORK OPPORTUNITIES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

OUR ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PATHWAY PROGRAM CAN HELP YOU GET THERE

Canada offers international students the opportunity to work during their studies and after graduating. The following information is an overview of options. To ensure you understand the requirements, please visit the [Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada \(IRCC\)](https://www.ircc.gc.ca) website. IRCC is the department responsible for immigration to Canada and for issuing study permits and student work permits.

WORK WHILE YOU STUDY*

*You are eligible once you start at college or university provided the institution is a Designated Learning Institution (DLI) recognized by the Canadian government.

Must apply for post-grad work permit within 180 days of program completion. Must have a valid study permit during the time of study.
HOW LONG IS YOUR WORK PERMIT?	Depending on the length of your program, your post-graduate work permit may be issued for 8 months up to maximum 3 years.
HOW MANY HOURS CAN YOU WORK?	Full-time, open work permit.

HOW TO APPLY

Students can apply before or after their English course start date. However, there is a minimum of 8 weeks' enrollment required. If you know before arriving at Kaplan that you want to apply for UPS, we'll start helping you right away. If you decide to use UPS once you arrive, you'll sit down for an information session with an advisor who will take you through all the steps.

UPS CANADA INQUIRY FORM

1. Send the completed UPS inquiry form along with a copy of your transcripts to your Kaplan Representative
2. Receive a personalized list of programs at partner institutions and help selecting one based on your English level, grades, future objectives, and preferred study location
3. Choose your college or university and let your Kaplan Representative know
4. Kaplan International will apply to one of the partner institutes on your behalf
5. Receive your Conditional Letter of Acceptance; depending on the partner institution, this may take 2-12 weeks to receive
