



HOW TO APPLY

Students can apply before or after their English course start date. However, there is a minimum of 8 weeks' enrollment required. If you know before arriving at Kaplan that you want to apply for UPS, we'll start helping you right away. If you decide to use UPS once you arrive, you'll sit down for an information session with an advisor who will take you through all the steps.

- 1. Send the completed UPS inquiry form along with a copy of your transcript to your Kaplan Representative
- 2. Receive a personalized list of programs at partner institutions and help selecting one based on your English level, grades, future objectives, and preferred study location
- 3. Choose your university or college and let your Kaplan Representative know
- 4. Kaplan International will apply to one or more (up to three) of the partner institutes on your behalf
- 5. Receive your Conditional Letter of Acceptance (CLA); this may take 2-8 weeks to receive
