2. STUDY PLAN

6. TRANSFER TO COLLEGE!

Once you have completed the B2-Higher Intermediate English level and a minimum of 5 weeks of the EAP Specific Skills class at Kaplan - you will be ready for transfer to AOLCC!

3. CONDITIONAL LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE

Depending on your situation, you will either receive your CLOA before you leave your home country or after you start at Kaplan. This document will assist you with obtaining a study permit in Canada.

4. UNIVERSITY PLACEMENT SERVICE

You will have access to the University Placement Service during your studies at Kaplan which includes: regular academic meetings and support, application assistance, liaising with AOLCC on your behalf, and stepby-step guidance.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS



AOLCC will accept the completion of Kaplan's B2-Higher Intermediate level in combination with a minimum of five weeks of the English for Academic Pathways Specific Skills class in lieu of any other English examination or testing such as TOEFL or IELTS.

Note: The University Placement Service is available to students who study at Kaplan for 8+ weeks for a charge of \$175 CAD. The service is complimentary for students enrolled for 16+ weeks.
