Ranked number three on the list of best countries 2021 (USNews survey), esp. for education, entrepreneurship, agility, forward thinking and quality of life






Number one economy in Europe and number four worldwide (behind US, China and Japan) with excellent employment opportunities for graduates and skilled individuals.







German has the highest number of native speakers in the European Union (Germany, Switzerland, Austria, Luxembourg and Liechtenstein have German as the official language) and is the secondmost commonly used scientific language in the world



# HIGHER EDUCATION IN GERMANY

- German universities enjoy an excellent global reputation and their graduates are highly sought-after in the job market.
- Over 400 institutions offer a range of almost 17,000 undergraduate and postgraduate degree programs.

# Focus on Science: Universities

- Mainly teach theoretical knowledge and emphasise research
- Usually offer a wide range of different subjects
- Specialised unis call themselves technical universities or colleges of education.

# Applied Sciences - Focus more on professional

- Range of subjects comprises specific fields such as technology, economics, social work or media.
- In the practical phases, students complete work placements or projects, often in businesses.

# Colleges of Art and Music

- Train young artists such as musicians, architects, fine artists and designers.
- Admission requirements include a specific talent which applicants must demonstrate in an entrance examination.

### INIVERSITY HIGHER EDUCATION IN GERMANY

**PUBLIC** VS PRIVATE

**Private** 

(ca. 30%, mostly

HAW/FH)

**Public** 

(ca. 60%)



#### Publicly funded - "Free"

#### **Entrance requirements**

High, usually defined by GPA ("Numerus Clausus")

#### **Intakes**

Winter semester (October) Summer semester (February)

#### **Application**

Through federal application and allocation system "uni-assist" - Student chooses study major, not institution

#### **Advantages**

+ Higher degree of internationalization + Reputation and ranking

+ Better chances for an academic scholarship

+ No tuition fees

### **Funded by tuition fees**

(note: fees are typically much lower than in UK/USA/AUS/CAN)

#### **Entrance requirements**

Set by institutions, usually more lenient

#### Intakes

Variable at each institution

#### **Application**

Direct at institution

- Student chooses study major and institution

#### Advantages:

- + More practice- and industry-oriented
- + Innovative degrees in new study fields
- + Visa for English language programs
- + Easier access / more flexibility
- + Smaller classes

# **Step 1: Inquiry and Assessment**

### **Applicant to submit:**

#### **Pre-Assessment Form**

incl. desired study major(s) and start date

### **Passport copy**

### **Academic Transcripts**

Undergraduate: High school diploma + other relevant qualifications

Postgraduate: BA degree certificate + other relevant qualifications

### Proof of prior German knowledge

(if available)

### **Alpadia Pre-Evaluation Report\* (Pre-Check)**

- Establish
  - o Eligibility for desired study program
  - Availability of desired study program
  - Alternatives
- Proposal of timeline and action plan



# **Step 2: CONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE**

### **Direct entry**


**Undergraduate and Postgraduate** CLA in desired study major from a German university



### **Indirect entry**

**Undergraduate only** 

Invitation to entrance exam ("Aufnahmeprüfung") at a public Studienkolleg



### Alpadia University Application Package\*

- SEF: Student Eligibility Form (Pre-Check)
- University Application to obtain one Conditional Letter of Acceptance (CLA) from a Public University OR invitation to the entry test at a Public Studienkolleg
- A study plan / curriculm for the visa application
   Turnaround time: 12-16 weeks, fast-track 3 weeks
   \* mandatory, fee EUR 550.00

#### Note:

The CLA is the "in-principle" confirmation of eligibility for the chosen study major by one university. The student has the freedom to apply at different universities for the final placement (step 5) after successful completion of the language course at Alpadia in Germany.

# Alpadia Visa Assistance Service Package\*

- Identification of documents to present to the German Embassy
- Assistance in setting up the blocked bank account (EUR 10,236 / Year ⇔ EUR 853 / Month) and getting health insurance in Germany
- Booking the visa appointment w/ the German Embassy
- Review and revise the visa application form & documents

8-12 weeks \* Optional, fee EUR 300



## **Step 5: UNIVERSITY PLACEMENT**

### **Starting Dates University**

Winter Semester : October

Application deadline: mid-July

Summer Semester : February

Application deadline: early January

**Starting Date Studienkolleg: September** 

Application deadline: July

#### Note:

Intake and timeline are identified in the application package (step 2) and the student will be accordingly supervised and coached by our UPP counselor at school.

### **Alpadia University Placement Package \***

- Evaluation of admission possibilities @ various Stk/UG/PG for desired program
- Shortlisting programs based on applicant's set of criteria, application deadline, admission requirements, location, etc.
- Establishing a roadmap and its timeline for the application process
- Document preparation including CV and motivational letter
- Notarization of required original copies when applicable
- · Maximizing the number of admissions
- Assistance in finding & registering for public health insurance
- Preparing the documents to switch visa status to student visa at local migration office
