

SCHOOL SAFETY

- Hand sanitiser at the front door
- Temperature checks for all students/staff/visitors
- Masks worn inside the school
- Hand sanitiser/wipes in every classroom







SCHOOL SAFETY

- Staggered class times to avoid congestion (8.15/8.30/8.45/9.00)
- Chairs in classroom 1m apart Rooms cleaned after each use
- Teachers wear visors
- No paper handouts
- Indoor common areas closed
- Common areas (door handles/banisters) cleaned in the middle of the day
- Garden open and furniture distanced
- Social programme restarting on a small scale (in school activities/trips for 5 students or fewer)
- Students from countries who need to quarantine take the first 2 weeks of their class online



TRAVEL TO THE UK

Provide proof of a negative coronavirus test - 72 hrs. before travel
You will only be allowed to entre UK with valid negative COVID

QUARANTINE RULES

Where?

- In your own home, at your friends or family, hotel or at **Kaplan's accommodation**
- You must quarantine in one place for the full quarantine period, where you can have food and other necessities delivered.
- You must quarantine at the address you provided on the passenger locator form.

How long?

- You must quarantine 10 full consecutive days* after the day you arrived up until 11:59pm day 10. The day
 after arrival is considered 'day 1'
- If you break the quarantine rules, you may face a penalty of up to £10,000.

Those with both vaccinations still need to abide by these rules.

QUARANTINE RULES

Testing in quarantine

Tests will be taken in your own accommodation

First self-test : Day 2

- You will need to take a COVID-19 test on or before day 2 of your quarantine period. The day of arrival in England will be treated as day 0
- If you get a positive result from your day-2 test, you do not need to take a test on day 8.

Second self-test: Day 8

- You need to take a COVID-19 test on or after day 8, unless you got a positive result from your day-2 test.
- If you get a positive test result from your day-8 test you will need to quarantine immediately and continue for 10 days.

You may leave the place where you're quarantining, If you've quarantined for 10 full days and received a negative result to both your day-2 and day-8 tests, and you are well.

*In England, there is an optional "test to release" scheme available. You can book and pay for an additional PCR test on day 5, and if it is negative and you are well, you can stop self-isolation earlier than planned. You still need to take your day 8 test, but you are free to leave your accommodation sooner.

CURRENT QUARANTINE PROMO

As we still have restrictions when travelling to the UK with most countries on the amber list, we have devised a new promotion to try and push summer bookings. This includes:

- 1 week of free residence if a minimum of 3 weeks of tuition and residence is booked.
- Kaplan will pay for test and release (up to £55) in England so that students only have to quarantine for 5 days. In Scotland, Kaplan will pay up to £55 to cover the cost of the usual day 2 and day 8 tests but students are not eligible for the day 5 test under Scottish law.
- As always, this is subject to availability but homestay may be given as an option if we run out of residence rooms.
- Valid for bookings who book and arrive by 28/08/2021.
- Please quote KL22AE1 when booking.

ACCOMMODATION

Life in a Homestay

Our homestays are experienced and are fully up to date with what restrictions are currently in the UK/Ireland and can help explain them to you. If you need to self-isolate, our hosts will ensure you have everything you need to be comfortable and can even provide you with packed lunches if you like!

Some homestay hosts will be travelling to work, others may be working from home. Some will be relaxed about the situation, but others may be waiting for their second vaccination and may be limiting their social interactions as a result.

Life in a Residence

Our residence partners are experts at supporting our students. They are also fully conversant with the current laws and restrictions and can help explain them to you. The residence staff can help deliver your shopping to your room whilst you are self-isolating and will ensure that you have everything you need to be comfortable during this time.

In line with the law, some common spaces (e.g., gyms, cinema rooms, games rooms etc.) will have restricted access until lockdown eases further. The residence will be able to advise you how to book and use these spaces.
